

Use of BICYCLES in the Natural Park of the Montgó:

(Decree 229/2007 Art 45-4)

-You can ride your bike on tracks, streets and roads throughout the Park.

-It is **NOT allowed** the transit of bicycles through paths or countryside within the Natural Park.

-Remember that the conservation of species of flora and fauna in danger, the ethnological heritage and respect for other users is responsibility of all.

-The increase in erosion and opening of new paths affects in a very negative way to the environment.

WHEN YOU RIDE YOUR BIKE, REMEMBER:

-Use authorized tracks, streets and roads, without driving on paths, cross-country, or opening new ones.

-Avoid skidding and dragging the wheel because you will irreversibly damage the ground. Don't go fast into curves without visibility.

-Respect no-go signs and respect private property.

-Give way to other road users, especially pedestrians. Always go forward on the left, reducing speed and keeping at least one meter away.

-Choose, paths less used by pedestrians.

-Respect animals and plants, nature is his home.

-Do not leave any food or waste, collect any residue you find when it's possible.

-Forget the rush, always remember that we go out to enjoy the environment, not to compete.
