

ADAPTED BATH 2020

1. Description of the service:

From the 1st of July 2020, there will be the opportunity for citizens to request an adapted swim service at Punta el Raset, Marineta Casiana and Bovetes beaches.

The adapted bathing hours will be as follows: **Monday to Sunday from 11:30 to 19:00**. On the beaches of Punta el Raset, Marineta Casiana and Bovetes.

The service will follow a system of appointments that can be requested by calling **966435031- 666864940 from Monday to Friday from 10:00 to 13:00**.

The person who is interested in the adapted bathing will be attended by the person in charge to give him/her an appointment in one of the different beaches.

No bathing will be allowed without an appointment.

The activity will last one hour. For large groups (retirement homes, associations, etc.), the coordinator should be contacted and he will adapt the service according to the demand made. He will be in charge of sizing up the service and adapting the resource to the group's needs.

The applicant for the adapted bath must be accompanied by two people for the session of adapted bathing. Under no circumstances will Red Cross staff have contact with users during the activity. They will simply bring the material for the enjoyment of the beach, whether adapted crutches or buggies.

Users must sign a document discharging the responsibilities of the workers.

Users must bring a pen and an accredited document to sign documents

2. Functions of the worker or volunteer:

The technical material to be used by the user must be located in the area called LIMPIO.

Once the bathing is over, you must leave the technical material in the area called SUCIA.

Red Cross staff will go to the SUCIA area with the agreed safety and hygiene measures and will proceed to disinfect the material thoroughly.

Once disinfected it will be left again in the LIMPIO zone.

The person in charge of the adapted bathing will wear gloves, a mask etc during all operations.

The lifeguards will be provided with glasses and water boots to carry out the disinfection.

Hydroalcoholic gel in the bathing area will be provided

The chair may only be used on green-flag days. In no circumstances will the staff accompany the user into the water, we only provide the material and disinfection

3. Recommendations

- We will try to reduce the number of people providing the service and if possible have the same worker or volunteer always doing this work to reduce the number of cross infections.

- The person and accompanying persons should wash their hands with hydroalcoholic gel before leaving the bath.

- The user must wear a surgical mask to perform the activity. If you are accompanied by someone, they must also wear a surgical mask. Our staff, acting with only one pair of gloves, will first remove the gloves, wash with gel and THEN remove the mask avoiding touching the front of the mask
